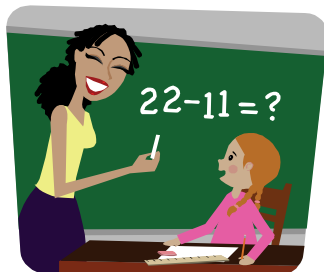

**Communication Applications**

Students taking high school courses will follow the same grading guidelines as students in grades 9-12. Final semester examinations will be given on a schedule set at each intermediate campus. The semester final examination (session) shall count no more than 16 percent of the total session grade.

A student who misses the semester examination must have a note from either the family physician or the school nurse verifying the illness. If it is necessary for a student to miss an examination, he should have his parent or guardian contact the nurse on the day of the exam. No exam will be given early. Make-up exams will be given in the case of illness or death in the immediate family.

A student missing an exam will be given a zero on the examination unless it was missed due to an excused absence. It must be made up in accordance with the schedule established by the school administration. A student may not obtain an early dismissal from any scheduled semester exam.
