

**No Pass/No Play Guidelines**  
**Klein ISD**  
**2008-2009**

The information below, based on Senate Bill 1, TEA/UIIL interpretations and KISD administrative decisions, represents KISD No Pass/No Play Guidelines for 2008-2009:

1. Students who are eligible throughout a six weeks grading period and pass all courses at the end of that six weeks grading period will maintain their eligibility throughout the following six weeks grading period.
2. Students lose their eligibility by failing one or more courses at the end of a six weeks grading period. They become ineligible seven (7) calendar days after the last day of the six weeks grading period. They are ineligible for three (3) weeks. \*
3. Students can regain their eligibility in two ways:
  - Pass all courses at the progress report check, which is at the end of the third week of the six weeks grading period. If passing, eligibility is restored seven (7) calendar days later. \*
  - Pass all courses at the end of the six weeks grading period. Their eligibility is restored seven (7) calendar days later.
4. Ineligible students who are still failing at a progress report check remain ineligible for another three (3) weeks. \*
  - If they pass all courses at the end of the six weeks grading period in which they are ineligible, their eligibility will be restored seven (7) calendar days after the end of the six weeks grading period.
  - If they fail one or more courses at the end of the aforementioned six weeks grading period, their ineligibility will continue pending a progress report check.

\* Some vacation periods and calendar adjustments will affect the number of days.

## KISD No Pass / No Play (Eligibility for Band)

### **BOTTOM LINE**

- 1. Report Cards** – It only takes one failing grade (69 or lower) in any class to become ineligible.

An incomplete (I) is treated the same as a failing grade until the student has made up the work and the teacher has recorded an official grade.

- 2. Progress Reports** – Students can become eligible IF they are passing every class on the Progress Report.

Students DO NOT become ineligible for a failing grade on a progress report if they had all passing grades on the previous report card. Students can get an “I” for a progress report grade. “I’s” are treated the same as a failing grade until the student has made up the work and the teacher has recorded an official grade.

- 3. All passing grades on the report card**, student is eligible until the next report card comes out.

- 4. KISD** expects all eligible students to participate in required activities, such as marching band performances and competitions.

- 5. Concerts or recitals at Klein Collins** are not extracurricular events – Eligible status does not matter and all students participate in these performances.

Events that are extracurricular, when eligible status does matter, include football games, marching contests, region band/orchestra tryouts, solo & ensemble contests, UIL Concert & Sight Reading contests and the Lone Star Festival in Dallas (April). Ineligible students are prohibited from participation in these by the State of Texas.

#### **In addition:**

Students may enter a competition (region band tryouts, solo & ensemble contests) when they are not eligible, IF there is an opportunity to regain their eligible status before the actual competition. HOWEVER, entry fees cannot be refunded if the student does not become eligible.

Students may pay to go on the entire Dallas Trip (in April) when they are not eligible. HOWEVER, money cannot be refunded after the dates listed on the trip information sheet if the student is not eligible on the day of the trip.
