GENERAL COURSE INFORMATION:

Students may take a maximum of three different courses for credit recovery over the two summer sessions.

TAKS Remediation Courses – A student who enrolls in a TAKS Remediation course **and demonstrates proficiency on an end-of-session assessment** may earn back his/her elective for the following year. Adequate progress on benchmark testing in the Fall 2009 must be maintained. **TAKS Remediation is not a credit recovery course. Tuition of \$180 applies.**

Student Success Initiative (SSI)-Required for 8th grade students who did not pass the first or second administration of Reading or Math TAKS. Tuition free for SSI students.

Classes are offered if there is a minimum enrollment of twenty (20) students and a teacher is available. Classes are filled as registrations are received.

8th grade students may take Health or Communication Applications for original credit. Please contact your counselor for enrollment information.

ESL Basic Interpersonal Communication Skills (BICS)-

This course is designed for struggling or failing 8th graders transitioning to high school, and for 6th and 7th graders who would benefit from summer ESL instruction. Counselor recommendation is required and students must attend first session, all day. Class size is limited to 16 students. Transportation will be provided, if needed, for eligible students.

*With counselor approval if only one SSI subject is needed

TUITION PAYMENT PLAN

Students who attended KISD during the 2008-2009 school year and who qualify for free or reduced lunch service will be eligible for a payment plan. This provision is available for academic classes but excludes transportation and all recreational programs. Providing that the student does not currently owe any fines or fees to the KISD, a down payment of no less than 50% may be made at the time of registration with the balance of the tuition to be paid at the summer campus by the sixth class day of the session attended. The parent/guardian must sign a special request form for the payment plan. Detailed instructions regarding partial payment will be available at the registration site.

SUMMER SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch service and need to enroll in Credit Recovery courses may apply for a Summer School Scholarship. These scholarships will be awarded based on the student's need and the availability of funds. Please contact the campus administrator for more information.

TRANSPORTATION PROCEDURES AND FEES

Each elementary school will be a pick-up and delivery site for Summer School students on Klein ISD buses. **The fee will be \$100 for each session.** Transportation fees must be paid in full at the time the bus pass is purchased. **Transportation will be available for morning drop-off and afternoon pick up only.** If an intermediate student is only attending one class (section) each summer session, the parent must make other arrangements for transportation. Details will be available at registration. Transportation for SSI students will be provided without charge.

GRADING PROCEDURES

For students who failed English language arts, mathematics, social studies or science, credit for the failed course will be earned with a passing summer school grade.

COURSE AUDITING

With the approval of the summer school session principal, students who have not met minimum expectations on a section of their most recent TAKS may audit those classes, on space available only. Students who audit a course to improve skills will not have changes made to prior grades. **Tuition of \$180 applies.**

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Attendance in summer school is critical because of the increased class time per day. Any student absent more than two (2) days will not receive credit for that session. All other rules and regulations in the *Klein ISD Intermediate School Handbook* will be in effect.

LUNCH PROCEDURES

Breakfast (\$1.10) and lunch (\$2.00) will be available for intermediate students daily. Lunch may be brought from home or purchased in the cafeteria. Students who qualify for free or reduced breakfast/lunch during the regular school year will be provided the same service during the summer program.
